#### **SUMMARY:**

**Verity Mackintosh** is a producer and storyteller with over 20 years' experience spanning factual television, narrative film, and virtual reality. Based in Te Awakairangi ki Tai (Hutt Valley), she is the Managing Director and Lead Producer of Krafty Productions and AKU Films. She crafts stories with heart and compassion for global audiences. In addition to her work with these companies, Verity is also available to line produce for other production houses.

Her credits include developing and producing the documentaries Joy Full & Fearless, Puhikura, China's Schindlers, Shaanxi: China's Great Gateway, and formats for Discovery APAC including Most Iconic: Dongguan's Agarwood and Smart China. She has also developed China From Above 2 and Jackie Chan's Green Heroes for National Geographic, as

well as award-winning short dramas Washday, *Pūrea*, and *Ministry of Jingle*.

2025 marks the premiere of the award-winning feature drama KŌKĀ, written and directed by the legendary Kath Akuhata-Brown. The film was selected to open this year's Māoriland Film Festival and was awarded the People's Choice Award for Best Drama at Māoriland 2025.

Joy Full & Fearless is due for release in September 2025. This feature documentary, directed by Clare Burgess, celebrates the indomitable New Zealand author Joy Cowley.

Verity has lived and worked overseas in Taiwan and China, and brings a strong track record of cross-cultural collaboration. Her ability to work proficiently in English and Mandarin, along with an evolving knowledge of Te Reo Māori nurtured through years of immersion in kaupapa Māori spaces, has enabled her to contribute meaningfully to diverse teams across Aotearoa New Zealand, China, Australia, the USA, and Taiwan.

She possesses end-to-end production capabilities, with experience in creative development and ideation, fundraising, budgeting and scheduling, creative collaboration, management, and stakeholder relationships and marketing. She also has experience in NZSPUR project management and delivery. Verity is proficient in MMB, MMS, Final Draft, Excel, Word, Photoshop, and Adobe Illustrator.
