Predomominantly Factual, Verity lead the development and production of over 40 hours of broadcast documentaries, a majority of these about China for foreign audiences, indigenous short films and feature films, while raising her three children.

In 2025, Verity produced "Kōkā" with support from He Pounamu Te Reo Māori Feature Fllm Initative in A NZSPUR project based at Avalon. This 107-Min majority Te Reo Māori drama feature showcases her capability to lead large-scale productions from inception to delivery.

Verity's diverse background and fluency in English, Mandarin, and novice Te Reo Māori have enabled her to collaborate effectively with multicultural teams in New Zealand, China, Australia, USA, and Taiwan.
